# **BUILDING PERMITS**

# Who needs a building permit?

- Anyone who plans to build a single family residence or remodel or renovate an existing single family residence will need to obtain a building permit.
- Anyone who plans to add exterior features/ accessory structures on the property of a single family residence including, but not limited to building a fence, deck, garage, shed, carport or installing a swimming pool will also need to obtain a building permit.
- Homeowners replacing existing fences, decks, etc. must also obtain a building permit.
- Anyone setting/installing a manufactured or modular-built home will also be required to obtain a building permit.

#### What if you're tearing something down?

 Anyone tearing down a permanent structure such as a home or garage — is required to obtain a demolition/wrecking permit.

# MISCELLANEOUS PERMITS & CERTIFICATES

# Certificate of occupancy

• Permits issued for new construction, renovations, additions and alterations to livable structures will also be subject to a \$25 Certificate of Occupancy fee. The C of O will be issued upon completion of the job described in the permit application process and upon finalization of all inspections by the city.

#### Improvement location

- New residential building projects, additions, renovations and other building projects that add features to your property including, but not limited to pools, garages, fencing, decks and some sheds will also will also be subject to a \$25 Improvement Location fee.
- \* Building projects less than 120 square feet will not be charged for Improvement Location.

#### **FEES**

# How much does a building permit cost?

- \$.08 per square foot.
   Square footage will be calculated by the extreme outside dimensions of the structure to include all stories, basements, decks, porches and occupiable attics.
   \$35.00 is the minimum permit fee.
- \$100 foundation only permit.
- \$.08 per square foot will be calculated for manufactured or modular built homes. \$35 is the minimum permit fee.

# How much does a building permit cost for a fence?

• \$35 permit required for the construction of new fences or the replacement of existing fences. A permit is not required if you are replacing/ repairing sections of an existing fence.

#### How much does a building permit cost for a pool?

- \$35 permit required for the installation of an above ground pool with a capable water depth of 42 inches.
- \$75 permit required for installation of an in ground pool.

#### How much does a demolition/wrecking permit cost?

• \$.02 per square foot of the building area. \$35 is the minimum permit fee.

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#### **ELECTRICAL PERMITS**

# Who needs an electrical permit?

- The construction of any new single family residence requires electrical permits. This oftentimes includes a permit for a temporary pole to provide electric during construction and an additional permit for the new, permanent service that will be provided to the home.
- Permits are also required for anyone making alterations and upgrades to an existing electrical service in a single family residence.
- Homeowners and property owners who have had a meter pulled by the electric provider will need to obtain a permit to have service restored.
- Anyone installing a swimming pool may need an electrical permit for the installation of the pool pump, which requires connection to a ground fault interrupter circuit (GFIC).

#### PHIMBING PERMITS

# Who needs an electrical permit?

• Anyone installing new plumbing in a new single family residence or replacing or upgrading plumbing in an existing residence must obtain a permit. This includes replacement of water heaters.

#### **HVAC PERMITS**

#### Who needs an HVAC permit?

• Anyone installing new heating and/or cooling systems or replacement heating and/or cooling systems in a single family residence.

#### **FFFS**

# How much does an electrical permit cost?

- \$.50 per amp for new or replacement electrical service. (Three inspections required.)
- \$35 temporary pole
- \$70 alterations to an existing electrical service (including, but not limited to placement of new outlets and fixtures)
   (Two inspections required.)
- \$35 installation of an electrical meter. (One inspection required.)
- \$35 service for manufactured or modular built homes. (One inspection required.)
- \$35 per additional inspection for services not listed.

# **FFFS**

# How much does a plumbing permit cost?

- \$50 installation of new plumbing work, plus first fixture
  \$3 for each additional fixture. Minimum permit of \$85.
- \$35 water heater replacement; alterations to existing plumbing and plumbing for manufactured or modular built homes.

#### **FFFS**

# How much does a plumbing permit cost?

- \$50 installation or replacement of a gas, electric or solid heating system.
- \$50 installation or replacement of an air conditioning system.
